STUDENT BODY ORGANIZATION

The [Associated Students](#) of Humboldt State University (AS) is the official student governing body. It operates under a constitution of student choosing. Its effective governing agency is the Associated Students' Council. Authority and supervision over associated student body matters are those minimally required by law and state regulation.

STUDENT CLUBS AND ACTIVITIES

In the [Student Clubs and Activities Office](#) (located in the UC South Lounge below the HSU Bookstore), information is available for the campus community to assist student organizations with facilitating club events, understanding campus policy and procedures, and a variety of other support. This is also the student hub for campus co-curricular involvement, especially in regards to student clubs and organizations. The Clubs Office is always in search of faculty and staff advisors. STUDENT CONDUCT

The University does not act *in loco parentis*. The conduct of students is governed by Sections [41301](#), [41302](#) and [41303](#) of Title V of the California Code of Regulations and by the Chancellor's Executive Order [No. 970](#), supplemented by the local residential life policies, copies of which are available in the [Office of the Vice President for Student Affairs](#) (see [Appendix H](#)).

HAZING

Hazing is forbidden by regulations of the trustees, and under the [Student Conduct Code](#) hazing invokes disciplinary actions that could be as severe as expulsion.

ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY

All enrolled students at Humboldt State University are eligible to participate in intercollegiate athletics competition as long as they meet the eligibility provisions of those regional and national intercollegiate athletic agencies in which the university has membership. Currently these agencies are the [California Collegiate Athletic Conference](#), the [Great Northwest Athletic Conference](#) and the [National Collegiate Athletic Association](#).

STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNIVERSITY

The faculty, students, and administration have agreed that there should be student participation in advising the administration of the university. Students are voting members on a number of university committees, including such bodies as: the Integrated Curriculum Committee (ICC), University Resources & Planning Committee (URPC), the [University Senate](#), University Policies Committees (UPC), Intercollegiate Athletic Advisory Committee (IAAC), and the Student Grievance Committee.

DINING SERVICES

All University dining services are managed by [HSU Dining Services](#), part of the [University Center](#) with administrative offices in the University Center. Residence hall students dine primarily in the Jolly Giant Dining Room (The J), although residence students and those off-campus students purchasing the meal plan may eat in any of the many other dining facilities on campus. Cash/Credit Card meal service on campus is available to all members of the campus community in Windows Cafe, the Depot, Library Café, Hilltop Marketplace and College Creek Marketplace.
