This executive order is issued under the authority granted by Education Code Sections 89035 and 89700, Standing Orders of the Board of Trustees, Chapter II, i, and Board of Trustees' Resolution RFIN 03-04-00, and consonant with Executive Order Number 740.

Effective February 21, 2007, Humboldt State University is authorized to establish a Category III Miscellaneous Course Fee for PE 118, Bowling Facility Fee, at a rate of \$40 per semester to cover the cost of the lanes and shoes for the semester; and a Category III Miscellaneous Course Fee Range for International Study Abroad Programs, at a fee range of \$0-\$4000 depending on the location of the program. The Study Abroad Fee for each department and/or location will be presented to the Student Fee Advisory Committee and then approved by the President.

In accordance with Section 89721(l) of the Education Code, revenue collected from Category III fees shall be deposited in a local trust account.
